COVID-19



As you know we are now in a National Lockdown situation.

The main changes are:

Stay at home

Everyone will be asked to immediately stay at home and only leave for the [following specific reasons](#):

- To go to work or provide voluntary or charitable services, if you cannot reasonably do so from home – this includes key workers and those in the construction industry.
- To shop for food and/or medicine for yourself or a vulnerable person.
- To provide care or help to a vulnerable person.
- To exercise – see gov.uk for specific rules.
- To seek medical care or an appointment or avoid injury, illness or risk of harm, including domestic abuse.
- To meet your [support bubble](#) or [childcare bubble](#) where necessary, but only if you are legally permitted to form one.
- To attend education or childcare if you are eligible.

School provision



Remote Learning

As you are aware, we have had a significant change to our Remote Learning offer following additional guidance released from the DfE. All parents will have received a separate letter detailing these changes.

We do recognise that everyone's personal situation is very different right now, so (whilst we are keen for your child to engage) please do not put undue pressure on your family situation to complete everything.

Children of critical workers or those who are vulnerable

We are continuing to support a high volume of critical worker children/vulnerable children at present. If you are a critical worker who is **able to have your child at home for some of the time**, please do this where you can. These children are in year group bubbles (one bubble per year group) to reduce transmission rates. Each group is led by an adult each day - sometimes this is a teacher and sometimes this is a teaching partner.

The children who are in school are following exactly the same learning as their peers at home to ensure consistent coverage, this includes watching the live stream from the year group teachers as it is delivered.


