Year 2 Term 4 Traditional Tales Choice Grid

For the rest of this term we will continue to send home weekly spelling grids alongside this homework grid. Your child will need to pick **one task each week** making sure that **one of each colour** (red, blue, black and green) is completed over the term (5 tasks to be completed before Easter holidays). You are welcome to complete any extra activities too! Please encourage your child to choose their tasks, it is important that they have lots of ownership and are as creative as they like. Each Friday we will ask the children to share any task they have done that week in class so please continue to hand in Homework Folders by the Thursday of each week, along with their completed task. For practical activities you could take a photograph or complete a drawing or present it a different way!

Create a scene from a traditional tale in a shoe box.	Imagine you are Goldilocks and write an apology letter to The Three Bears. Remember capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks. Could you make up an address for the letter?	Make a list for the Three Little Pigs of the materials you can find in your home. What words could you use to describe them? E.g. shiny, waterproof, rough, absorbent etc.
Visit a library and read some traditional tales or some traditional tales with a twist.	Practise telling the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.	Design and make a house for a character from a traditional tale.
Design and make/draw a maze for Hansel and Gretel to escape from.	Write one of your favourite traditional tales as a short play script. Remember to include all the characters and the part of a Narrator.	Draw some different beanstalks outside and measure them. Can you measure any plants in your garden? Can you write down the measurements and put them in order from smallest to largest?
Write a diary entry as if you are a traditional tale character e.g. the gingerbread man after he escaped from the oven; the wolf after he tried to eat the pigs; Jack after he'd been up the beanstalk. Remember capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.	Practise your 3 and 4 times tables. Can you say them in different characters voice's e.g. the giant, wolf, witch.	Make your own house of straw, sticks or bricks using materials at home or by building a den at Pilley Bridge or any other outdoor place. Do you think the Wolf could blow it down?
