For example: Hey diddle diddle, Incy Wincy spider, Jack and Jill etc. Can you spot any rhyming words?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Number hunt</u></p> <p>Look out for the numbers 11 to 20 when you are out and about. What is the number? What can you tell us about that number? For example: 12 has one ten and 2 ones.</p>

Round your middle? Can you pass a ball under your leg? Practise bouncing and then catching a ball.</p>
