Below you can find some home learning activity ideas to support your child's class work should they wish to extend their learning further.

Reading - Fossils Ask your teacher for a reading comprehension to complete on Fossils.	Reading - Poetry Ask your teacher for a reading comprehension to complete on Poetry.	Reading - Story ideas Ask your teacher for reading quiz cards about settings and characters.
Science Using your knowledge of forces or magnets, design an experiment or a game to share with the class.	Geography Design a treasure map - for a class book of maps - of either a real place or a made up place, using your knowledge of compasses, map keys and co-ordinates.	Model-making Make a model of a scene from a favourite story you have read or had read to you.
Homophones In a poster or dance/rap/song, help us remember the differences between these sets of homophones: too/to/two; there/their/they're You may work with a partner if you wish.	Talking about reading Take a set of reading cards to help you discuss ideas with a grown-up about the book you are reading. Display your answers in a leaflet/poster/powerpoint.	Maths Challenge Challenge yourself to learn your 4 or 8 times tables (or another times table). Play Hit the Button for 5 minutes every school night.
French colours Design a poster for the classroom to help other people learn 10 French colours: rouge, vert, jaune, bleu, noir, rose, orange, violet, gris et blanc.	Fact-finding mission Do an investigation or piece of research on a subject of your choice and come and give the class a talk about it - you may use powerpoint if you wish.	PSHCE In RE and PSHCE we are learning about the value of being kind to others. Do an act of kindness and come and tell us about it - what did you notice?
