

## Synopsis

A step back in time to explore events beyond living memory, and how people in history have discovered significant historical findings. Children will learn about archaeological digs around the world linked to dinosaurs.

## Term 1 – Step Back in Time – Part 1

### Why did the dinosaurs die out?

#### History/Geography
