

## Synopsis:

We'll be investigating what life was like in the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age, finding out how people lived and how they developed farming, settlements and belief systems.

## LEADING QUESTION: What happened when nomadic people settled?

### History/Geography

We are learning about how life changed during the Stone Age, starting with the Middle Stone Age and moving into the Neolithic, Bronze and Iron Ages. In Geography, we will discover where people in Stone Age Britain came from.

### Art

We will focus on drawing portraits. We will be developing observation skills and shading techniques.

### Maths

We will spend most of the term working on place value as the building blocks for the rest of the year's maths. Towards the end of the term, we will focus on geometry

### English

We will use the model text of Stone Age Boy to create a portal adventure story of our own. For our second unit of work, we will be writing a discussion text. We will be reading The Nowhere Emporium.

### PSHE

This will be covered in week one and is the Jigsaw unit 'Me in my world'.

### Music

We will learn the R&B song 'Let your spirit fly' using the Charanga scheme

### PE

The focus will be on netball in outdoor PE and jumping and balancing in indoor PE.

### Computing

Using Purple Mash we will be learning about internet safety.

### MFL

Using the scheme Language Angels, we will learn to introduce ourselves and say how we feel.

### Homework

We will be revisiting the 10x, 5x and 2x tables for our tests.  
Reading – 5x per week.
