

## Year 5 - Term 1 - How did Roman Culture Shape Great Britain?

### Synopsis

In this project, Year 5 will be learning about how the Roman Empire impacted the entertainment, infrastructure and urbanisation of Great Britain. They will look deeply at what Britain was like prior to the Roman invasion; the changes that occurred throughout their rule; and how this has impacted and shaped the culture of modern-day Britain.

### History/Geography

- Non-fiction – Discussion/Balanced Argument text. Outcome is to write a Balanced Argument answering the leading question at the end of the unit.
