#### Ancient Egyptian Day

- Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> April
- Workshops and activities in school run by an Ancient Egyptologist
- Children are invited to come to school dressed up as an Ancient Egyptian. The PTA's Costume Borrowing Library has a variety of Ancient Egyptian outfits if you would like to borrow one for your child [Naunton Park PTA](#).

Children will be learning about Ancient Egyptian mythology; pharaohs; hieroglyphs; and ancient numeracy as well as have the opportunity to take part in some Ancient Egyptian craft. They will see and examine artefacts and use resources brought in by our expert visitor. It was a great, interactive day last year and we are very excited that we can run it again.
