Term 5 & 6 trips & visitors for Year 4

Dear Parents,

Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visit and activity that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Terms 5 & 6.

Ancient Greek Day and Past Productions workshops

- Wednesday 20th May
- This will take place in school
- Past Productions workshop
- Children should come dressed up as an Ancient Greek for the day

This themed day will link to the children's topic about Ancient Greece. Children will learn about voting, myths and explore themes relating to life in Ancient Greece. During the day, Past Productions will be visiting to lead drama workshops for the children. There will also be an Ancient Greeks quiz and myth writing sessions.

Science Festival

- Tuesday 2nd June
- Montpellier, Cheltenham
- Event start time: 10am
- Event end time: 12pm
- Children will eat lunch at school as usual

This trip will support the children's science work in school, relating to our previous Leading Question and developing their scientific skills. The classes will visit the Maker Shack and attend a talk called "It's Only Water".

Clarinet Lessons

- These will take place weekly in school for 10 sessions

These sessions will give all the children additional music lessons, providing them with the opportunity to try a new instrument. The sessions will be led by a qualified instructor, and the cost also covers the cost of hiring the instruments.



Payment
