- Event start time 10:15am

- Children will need a snack, packed lunch and drink in a backpack.
- School uniform should be worn as usual with comfortable shoes for walking.
- Please send a rain jacket if there is a chance of rain, a sun hat and sun cream already applied.

This trip will support the children's science work in school. The children will learn more about animals at an event called 'There's a Zoo in Your House' and visit the Maker Shaker tent.

Payment
