Lesson details

Lessons take place on a Monday and a Friday during the school day. A timetable will be sent to all parents once numbers are confirmed. 20 minute and 30 minute lessons will be available on a one-to-one basis or in small groups (max 2). Lessons will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.

Cost of lessons:

£20 for 30 minutes (for 2 pupils together £10 each)

£14 for 20 minutes (for 2 pupils together £7 each)

Once I confirm your child's place, I will send payment details to you. Payment for lessons must be in advance (at least 1 week before the lessons) and I will invoice you at the beginning of each term.

Lessons missed by me will be made up where possible. Lessons missed by the pupil through illness will not be made up. For school trips or events please give me a week's notice wherever possible so that I can reschedule the lesson.

An acoustic guitar (or, if you have an electric guitar with amp and lead, you are welcome to bring it)
