



Dear Families,

We are now in a position to share details of our updated school uniform and our approach from September 2026.

To clarify, we will continue to accept both branded and non-branded uniform items, with the exception of our new compulsory PE tops, which must be purchased from our official uniform provider via the school website. The website is going to be down for a few days whilst they swap over the uniform. You should be able to purchase items next week.

As previously discussed, we are exceptionally proud of our pupils' achievements, attitudes, and behaviour. However, one area we are seeking to improve is the consistency of our uniform, which is currently not as uniform as it should be. Even last week we were showing two sets of parents around and they asked if we had a uniform. It does stand out that we do not look as good as other local schools. We do feel having a smart uniform is important, it helps children to understand the importance of pride in oneself and a sense of pride in representing our school community.

From September, we expect all pupils to wear:

- A sky blue polo shirt
- The new PE top

There will be a one-year transition period during which existing branded jumpers and cardigans may continue to be worn. As previously mentioned, if you have a particular supplier of polo shirts, jumpers, or cardigans that you prefer but would still like the school logo, you may send these items to our uniform provider, who will embroider them for you.

We are also introducing a new training top for PE, which is optional.

Please read the full guidance carefully, as there are updated expectations for school uniform from September 2026. We are going to be monitor uniform more strictly in September to ensure everyone is following the standards we require. In addition, we are working with our supplier to have old uniforms recycled – more information on this will follow.



School Uniform

Navy blue jumper or cardigan

Sky blue polo shirt – NEW

Charcoal grey trousers

Charcoal grey knee length shorts

Charcoal grey pinafore dress

Charcoal grey skirt

Charcoal grey tights

Charcoal grey short or long socks

Black shoes or plain black moulded trainers (no insignia)

Book bag with new logo – optional

Reception children can wear navy blue jogging bottoms

Summer Uniform

Blue gingham summer dress or playsuit – sky blue or pale blue (not navy blue)

Blue gingham summer shorts - sky blue or pale blue (not navy blue)

With white socks

Short cycling shorts can be worn under skirts, pinafores and summer dresses as long as they are shorter than the item.

PE kit

PE top in House colours - NEW and compulsory

Navy blue shorts

Navy blue jogging bottoms

Navy blue track bottoms

Trainers (preferably black)



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PE kits must be worn on PE days – children will come into school in their Kit. If a child is attending a club that requires PE kit on a non- PE day, they must bring this in and get changed.

FOREST SCHOOL - NEW

Navy blue long sleeve top (a wide range of shops supply these)

Navy blue jogging bottoms, cargo pants and/or waterproofs

Navy blue jumper

Trainers, wellies or outdoor boots

Coats will be worn depending on the weather

Uniform Accessories

Navy blue bobbles, scrunchies and headbands for hair

Long hair should be tied back and out of children's eyes

Navy blue baseball caps/hats – can be bought from our uniform shop or a shop of your choice

NO leggings should be worn

NO leggings under shorts or skirts

Sky blue polo shirts to be worn in September 2026

No white shirts or blouses

One year of swapping over form logo on jumpers and cardigans – and book bags

Sky blue polo shirts can be bought from a variety of supplier including Marks and Spencer, Next, Trutex, ECO outfitters and many other outlets.



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
