This week we are challenging you to write a **short story** from the point of view of an urban animal or bird during lockdown. 'Urban' means living in or close to a town or a city. You could choose a pet or a wild animal. With far less people about, the towns have changed quite a bit for animals, and there have been reports of some changing their behaviour. Try and include good writerly tactics, including speech punctuation and how someone is saying something; varied sentence starters; and conjunctions such as because, so, while, as, to extend your sentences.
