Dear Parents,

Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visit that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Term 4.

Wild Place Project

- Friday 17th March 2023
- The Wild Place Project, Bristol, BS10 7TP
- Depart school approx. 9:15am
- Return to school by 3:15pm (traffic permitting)
- Jogging trousers and wellies should be worn with a school jumper
- A waterproof jacket/coat should be worn
- Children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink

This experience will add to and support our Challenge Curriculum. Children will learn about the animals of Ghana and, more widely, Africa. The work will link to our Science topics of food chains, habitats and adaptations. During the day, children will enjoy an African Safari workshop and have access to the entire park.

Payment

The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £19.00 to cover the cost of transportation, entry and the workshop. No child will be prevented from going on the visit because their parents do not pay but we must point out that the visit may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. **All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by Monday 13th March 2023.** If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

Permission and help

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's trip. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trip. Please wait to hear back from our office staff about helping with this trip if you have kindly offered. ALL adults helping on the trip will need to bring ID unless this has already been shown to the school office staff since September of this academic year.

Pupil Premium

If your child receives Pupil Premium, the school will use the funding to pay for your child's trip. You do not need to make a contribution. You do, however, need to give permission for your child to attend by emailing the office as explained above.
