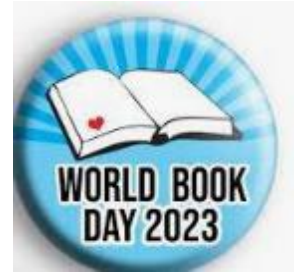


Dear Families,

On Friday 3rd March, we'll be celebrating World Book Day at Naunton Park and our theme this year is: Our Favourite Reads.



Our day will involve hearing stories, sharing and recommending good books.

We're also inviting children to come to school either dressed as a book character **OR** wearing something comfortable/cosy.

During the day, we will be holding a Book Exchange for the children and one for adults at pick-up time. Children may bring a nearly-new book into school any time from Monday 27th February and exchange it for a token. They can also bring in a grown-up book and exchange this for a grown-up book token for you. On Friday 3rd March they will then be able to swap their child's token for a book during the day and at the end of the day, if there are books left. There will also be a table for grown-ups to use their tokens at the end of the day on Friday.

Also, after school we'll also be hosting an Usborne Book Fair where children have the option to put their World Book Day voucher towards the purchase of a new book. More details on how you can order books will be in the newsletter.

We have had requests from parents about a school wish list for books therefore, for those of you who are interested, we will be setting up a Parentpay link for this purpose. More details to follow at a later date.

We hope this will be a lovely day of reading and fun for the children.
