### Term 6 trip for Year 3

Dear Parents,

Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visit that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Term 6.

#### Cheltenham Science Festival

- Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2023
- Montpellier, Cheltenham
- 10am departure from school
- 2pm departure from venue to return to school
- School uniform must be worn, and children should take a waterproof jacket and/or sunscreen depending on the forecast
- Children should bring a packed lunch and water bottle
- Children must bring appropriate footwear to walk to/from the venue

The workshop, "Healthy You, Healthy Planet" will link to the children's work from earlier in the year about healthy eating. Children will also explore further about the environment impact of global warming in the Caribbean, touched on already during curriculum time. In the workshop, children will learn from Forest Green Rovers staff about how to have a healthy, body, mind and planet. With the help of the Ministry of Eco Education, there will be games, activities and food tasting for the children to enjoy. Children will also visit The Maker Shack, which is a hands-on exploratory space where the children will be able to move safely in an enclosed space around a huge variety of activities.

#### Payment

**The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £10.50** to cover the cost of the above trip, including the workshops, games and activities. No child will be prevented from going on the visit because their parents do not pay but we must point out that the visit may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. **All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June.** If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

#### Permission and help

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's trip. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trip.
