Dear Parents,

Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visits that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Term 6.

Science Festival

- Cheltenham Science Festival, Montpellier Gardens, Cheltenham
- Friday 9th June 2023
- Pack lunch is required
- School uniform to be worn with a coat

This experience will support the children's learning of the KS2 science National Curriculum, most notably around sounds, everyday materials, forces, language and communication. Through the session, children will develop their problem-solving skills. They will be attending a workshop with Ruth Perkins from Science Made Simple, uncovering the mysteries of what sound is and how you turn it into music. Children will explore the questions, "Can you play music with a blowtorch and how about playing an instrument hands free?"

In the Net is an annual performance aimed at Year 4 children from each school across the county. Children will watch a performance by professional actors relating to online safety. Children will be taught more about keeping themselves and others safe when online, including the use of APPs and social media.
