Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visit that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Term 6.

#### Cheltenham Science Festival

- Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2023
- Montpellier Gardens, Cheltenham
- Event starts at 12:00pm
- Depart venue to return to school at 3:00pm, **due to return to school for 3:30pm pick up**
- School uniform must be worn
- A jacket/coat should be worn
- Children will be walking to/from the festival
- Children should take a packed lunch to enjoy in the Science Festival's picnic area

During the afternoon, children will take part in two workshops:

- Smash your goals with Mark Langtry, aka Mark the Science Guy, is a highly interactive, energetic and hilarious investigation into the science behind football. Children will discover some simple tips to improve their performance on and off the pitch with exciting demos, challenges and experiments.
- Get ready, get set, make! Children will bring their imaginations to life and invent their own creations in the MakerShack. They will code a robot, try out the latest technology, discover some curious squidgy stuff, and celebrate all things materials and making. They will hone their crafting skills with expert makers, crafters, scientists and engineers.

#### Payment

**The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £7.50** to cover the cost of the above activities. No child will be prevented from going on the visit because their parents do not pay but we must point out that the visit may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. **All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June.** If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

#### Permission and help

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's trip. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trip.
