### Terms 1-2 trips for Year 6

Dear Parents,

Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visit that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Terms 1 and 2.

#### Cheltenham Literature Festival

- Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October
- Montpellier Gardens, Cheltenham
- Event start time 10:30am
- Depart venue to return to school after lunch – a packed lunch will be required
- School uniform must be worn
- A jacket/coat should be worn
- Children will be walking to/from the festival
- Children should take a packed lunch to enjoy in the Literature Festival's picnic area

This experience will promote reading for enjoyment for the children. The children will attend a "History and Mystery" workshop by authors Phil Earle and Lesley Parr, which links with the children's World War 2 topic.

#### World War 2 Evacuation Experience

- Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> October
- Winchcombe Railway Station, GL54 5LD
- Start time at venue 9:30am
- Finish time at venue 2:00pm
- Children should dress up in WW2-style clothing and bring a pillow case or suitcase containing their lunch
- Children will need to take a packed lunch and drink for the day – we ask that, if possible, this is a 1940s-style picnic lunch

This immersive experience links with our history topic of World War 2. The children will have a steam train journey 'to the safety of the countryside' (taking a round-trip from Winchcombe station), experience an 'air raid', listen to a talk from a real WW2 evacuee and take part in a 1930s/40s firefighting practice.

#### Macbeth Interactive Workshop

- In school
- Young Shakespeare Company

This is a professionally filmed, interactive workshop package about Macbeth to give children the opportunity to participate in the Young Shakespeare Company's Active Storytelling workshops. Sections of storytelling are led by the workshop leader, combined with short extracts of Shakespeare's text performed by the Young Shakespeare Company actors. Literacy and creative arts follow-up activities are also provided by the YSC for use during the topic.

#### Payment

**The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £33.60** to cover the cost of all of the above activities and coach travel to/from Winchcombe. No child will be prevented from going on these visits because their parents do not pay but we must point out that the visit may have to be cancelled if we do not



receive sufficient contributions. **All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October.** If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

### **Permission and help**

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's trip. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trip. ### **Pupil Premium**
