#### Dear Families,

What a beautifully sunny start to the new academic year, albeit a little hot! Thankfully, the building works were all completed on time due to the hard work and dedication of the team from Carters and from our Site Manager, Mr Norton. The classrooms and toilets were signed off on Friday afternoon allowing us time to move furniture on the Monday morning INSET. We are so please with the overall finish – the classrooms look clean, fresh and inviting. We still have some furniture to be delivered but in the main the classrooms look stunning! Next month we start to plan the next phase which will take place over the summer holidays, two more years of work but I am glad that it is not causing any disruption to the children's learning.

Our INSET days were packed with training for the team and we welcomed 10 new staff. Training included feedback and marking, safeguarding, Rosenshine's Principles of Instruction and An Ethic of Excellence. I look forward to sharing some of this work at my next Head Teacher's Evening – Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> September 6pm.

Our children have settled in very well and have been engrossed in their artwork. Every new academic year we will focus on self-portraits and this year we have invited lots of artists to work with our children. New art books have been bought and will be passed up each year so that when our younger children leave in Y6 they will be able to see their progress in portraits over many years. The whole school has been focusing on Ron Berger's – Austin's Butterfly. A video that I have used in many training sessions over the years as it transforms thinking about feedback to children, multiple drafts and an ethic of excellence. The children have been fascinated watching this and if you have the time please do watch it with your child/children as this is not just about drawing a butterfly – it applies to all aspects of learning and an inspirational model of the power of perseverance and revision to improve quality. We look forward to lots of lovely events and more opportunities for parents to be in school. We are very excited to start class assemblies on Fridays, where parents can come in and see their children presenting their work. Please look out for the diary dates in the newsletters and on the school website yearly calendar. We made so much progress last year and I look forward to building on that and improving other aspects of school life at Naunton Park Primary School.

- Willing to undergo Enhanced DBS and Safeguarding checks. Willing to undertake relevant training in child protection and first aid. Specific details:


• The role will include solely supporting a child with additional needs, modelling excellent practice and putting strategies in place for the child. Sound knowledge of working with children with additional needs is preferred.
