Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visit that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Terms 1 and 2.

Birdland

- Tuesday 3rd October 2023
- Birdland, Rissington Road, Bourton on the Water, Cheltenham, GL53 2AY
- Departure 9:30am from school and back to school for arrival at 3pm (subject to traffic)
- Packed lunches will be required
- Leggings/joggers to be worn with school polo top and jumper
- Wellington boots or old trainers to be worn

This exciting trip will support our History topic about dinosaurs. The children will receive a talk about dinosaurs and have the chance to experience a 'dino dig'. We will also spend time looking at the penguins and flamingos.

Cheltenham Literature Festival

- Monday 9th October
- The Garden Theatre, Montpellier Gardens, Cheltenham
- Event start time 1:15pm (leave school at 12pm)
- Depart venue to return to school by 3:15pm
- School uniform must be worn
- A jacket/coat should be worn
- Children will be walking to/from the festival

This experience will promote reading for enjoyment for the children. The children will have the opportunity to experience poetry, ahead of our work with Kate Wakeling's poems later in the year during English lessons. During the festival, the children will be able to join in, get creative and be inspired by Kate Wakeling as she performs her poems for the children.

Payment
