

Synopsis:

What is civilisation and what was it like before the modern world? What do artefacts tell us about life in Iron Age and Bronze age? How did people live and how did they develop farming and beliefs?

What happened when nomadic people settled?

History/Geography

We are learning about how life changed during the Stone Age, starting with the Middle Stone and moving into the Neolithic and Bronze and Iron Ages. Geography is looking at where people in Stone Age Britain came from.

Art

We will focus on drawing portraits in Week 1. We will be developing observation skills and shading techniques.

Maths

We will spend most of the term working on place value as the building blocks for the rest of the year's maths. Towards the end of the term we will focus on geometry

English

We are using Talk 4 Writing and the model text of Stone Age Boy to create a portal adventure story of our own. For our second unit of work we will be writing a discussion text.

PSHE

This will be covered in week one and is the Jigsaw unit 'Me in my world'.

Music

We will learn the R&B song 'Let your spirit fly' using the Charanga scheme

PE

The focus will be on netball in outdoor PE and jumping and balancing in indoor PE.

Computing

Using Purple Mash we will be learning about internet safety.

MFL

Using the scheme Language Angels, we will learn to introduce ourselves and say how we feel.

Homework

We will be revisiting the 10 x, 5x and 2x tables for our tests. Reading – 5x per week.
