Synopsis and Key experiences- Y2

In this project year 2 will be comparing life in Cheltenham to life in Ghana. We will be studying the Geography of our local area and comparing that to the Geography of Accra (capital of Ghana) We will be finding out about how life in rural and urban Ghana differ.

Geography
