Terms 1 trips for Year 3

Dear Parents,

Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visits that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Term 1.

Bristol Museum

- Friday 6th October 2023
- Bristol Museum and Art Gallery, Bristol, BS8 1RL
- Departure 9:10am from school and back to school for arrival by 3:15pm (subject to traffic)
- Packed lunches will be required
- School uniform must be worn with a waterproof coat

This is an exciting opportunity for the children to take part in a Stone Age to Iron Age workshop at Bristol Museum. During the workshop, children will: handle artefacts including stone hand axes and flint tools up to 500,000 years old; investigate how tools were made and what they were used for; and, consider what evidence these artefacts provide about how people lived in the past.

Cheltenham Literature Festival

- Tuesday 10th October
- The Garden Theatre, Montpellier Gardens, Cheltenham
- Depart school by 9am
- Depart venue to return to school approx. 11am
- School uniform must be worn
- A jacket/coat should be worn
- Children will be walking to/from the festival
- Children will have their lunch in school as usual

This experience will promote reading for enjoyment for the children. We are excited to be going to see Chae Strathie, author of "So You Think You've Got it Bad? A Kid's Life as a Viking". This is one of a fabulous series of books designed to help inspire children to get excited by history and to discover what life might be like if they could travel back in time.

Payment

The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £22.59 to cover the cost of all of the above activities including transportation. No child will be prevented from joining in because their parents do not pay but we must point out that the visit may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. **All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by Wednesday 4th October.** If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

Permission and help

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's trip. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trip.
