Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about an activity

#### God and the Big Band virtual workshop

- Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2023
- Virtual workshop followed by activities

We have booked a virtual visit from 'God and The Big Bang' team to link with our RE unit based on Creation and Science. The workshops aims to equip young people with the tools they need in order to form their own opinions and engage in **rational, exciting, well-reasoned and thought-provoking discussion** about the part science plays in God's world.

The talks and workshops are **captivating and stimulating**, showcasing both **cutting-edge science** and personal and honest reflections about the intersection between science and faith.

Running for two hours, the workshops will feature two sessions as well as a live Q&A with the God and The Big Bang team. The first session will be livestreamed into your classroom featuring a member of our team. With live demonstrations and 'wow!' moments, pupils will be introduced to the compatibility of science and faith and start to think of some big questions.

The second session is a teacher led interactive investigation activity, with all the resources you need provided. Working in groups, pupils will be challenged to think about how we find answers to some of life's biggest questions.

Finally, the GatBB team will hold a live Q&A session for pupils to ask some of the questions they have come up with throughout the workshop- no question is off limits!
