Synopsis:

This piece of learning will start to focus on the life of Floella Benjamin and through doing this we will then look at Windrush. This will open up discussion about people coming from other countries to help England and create a diverse Britain.

Term 1 – What can we learn from Floella Benjamin about Windrush?

History/Geography

National Curriculum (History)

We will be finding out about the past and identifying different ways in which it is represented. We will learn about events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally. We will learn about he lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements.

National Curriculum (Geography)

We will learn to use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans studied at this key stage.

<u>Number and place value:</u> We will be learning about partitioning two-digit numbers, reading and writing two digit numbers and order two digit numbers.

Geometry: We will be learning about identifying and describing the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

<u>Addition:</u> We will be learning about adding 1's to two digit numbers by rounding and bridging, adding multiples of ten to two digit numbers and adding two, two digit numbers by partitioning and recombining.
