

Year 1 Term 2 How do our bodies work?

Synopsis:

This piece of learning will be science based. We will begin by looking closely at the Autumn season. Then we will be investigating how our bodies work. We will be looking at each of our senses. We will also have lots of visitors coming to talk to us about our bodies and senses, including Doctors and Dentists.
