Class – Y2 Blue

Art Week

During Art Week, we have been learning about primary and secondary colours. We have been learning how to mix secondary colours and have been using white and black to add tints and tones to the colours we created. The children have been able to carefully mix and colour match with brilliant accuracy. Additionally, we have created some super art pieces related to our RE work where we explored why Christmas is important to Christians. Using our colour mixing skills, we have created some amazing pieces of art as you can see below.





We are going to create our own version of a Starry Night and include the Nativity scene as a silhouette.



You will paint the sky by: Using primary colours to create purple Use white and black to create tints an tones to darken and lighten the night

When dry, we will use yellow (primary colour) and white to create a starry night scene.

Then we can add the silhouetted hills and stable. You are going to use your primary and secondary colour mixing skills to create your own version of this part of the panel below.





Class – Thames

What a fun-filled final week of term! On Monday, Year 4 got to enjoy a special swim session with toys, balls and goals and an inflatable course. Great fun was had by all.

We have also had lots of opportunities to be creative this week, with colour mixing watercolour paints and designing and creating our own pieces of art to represent the Trinity in RE. The photos show us using our colour mixing skills to carefully and accurately match paint colours to the Big Frieze we study each year in RE. At first this seemed simple as most of the picture is grey, but we then discovered there are far more shades of grey than we realised!



Yellow

We have been working on these skills in Yellow Class during our recent art and RE unit. I can mix primary colours to make secondary colours.

- I can improve my skill and control when painting.
- I can use thick and thin brushes.
- I can mix and match colours to artefacts.

We used our skills to create a collaborative piece of work, using the creation story image from the The Big Story of the Bible frieze as our inspiration. Christians believe that God made the world. What colours would God need in his paint box to create the world?



Class – Severn

In Year 5, we have been recreating the Big Frieze linked to the RE questions we have been studying. In order to have the outline we had to use tracing paper, copying the lines to create a print on the page. We learnt to colour mix, yellows and greens to complete our work and once we had practiced began with painting our work. We have worked really hard and produced some wonderful pieces.



Class – Avon

In the last few weeks in RE, we have been investigating the questions: Why do people believe in God? and Creation and Science - conflicting or complimentary? From this we devised our own questions and used our knowledge from this previous learning to present a non-chronological report to share the different points of view.



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
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Sherborne
