Year 6 Netball Lessons



This inspired him to work with Green (and Red) class to create a snowy image print. Nick asked the children for their snowy day ideas — a snowman was the most popular. Nick then drew the images on a polystyrene tile plate and took out the bits on the plate that he wanted to remain white. He then rolled blue printing ink on the plate, covered it with paper and used a clean roller firmly to make the ink transfer to the paper. Wow, it was like magic when Nick peeled the paper away. Can you see the cheeky owl in the finished print?









Class – Thames

In Thames class this week, we have been getting arty and creating mood boards to go with our leading question 'What are the long-term effects of water pollution for our planet?' The mood board was an expression of what they imagine when they think of water and the children used cuttings, materials, different textures and images to express their ideas.

Throughout the year, we are learning about the 4 seasons. We are learning to name them, know when they happen, think about the variations in weather and in the environment. We went on a 'Winter Walk' on Tuesday to The Rose Garden, however, it wasn't as cold as we thought it might be! So we went on another winter walk on Wednesday morning where we enjoyed looking at and exploring the frost. We had great fun mark making in it too! We then learnt how no two snowflakes are the same and printed snowflakes using tin foil and paint.
