

## **Year 1 Term 3 - Optional Creative Homework**

This term we are learning about the features of Cheltenham town. We will begin by exploring the area around our school including The Rose Garden, park, allotments and Bath Road. We will then be learning about some of the key sculptures (e.g. Gustav Holst, Neptune's fountain) and well known places including the Town Hall, Pittville Pump Room, Racecourse and the Eagle Star tower. We would like to set an optional challenge for your children related to our learning. Here are two different ideas — please discuss them with your child to select one. (However they can of course do both if they wish!)

- Draw a simple map. This could be in a traditional style with the location's drawn in relation to each other or as a line map, showing the places your child passes in a linear picture with labels and arrows. The map could be drawn, painted or even completed using a program on a computer or tablet with real images.



- Create a poster or leaflet about a particular place in Cheltenham that your child enjoys going to. This could be a park, shop, café, area - anywhere that they would like to tell others about! This could include photos, pictures, labels and perhaps even a few sentences.

Please send in your child's home learning whenever it is complete for them to share with the class.
