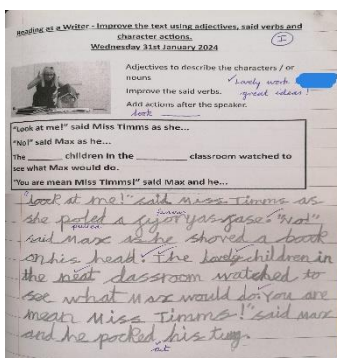
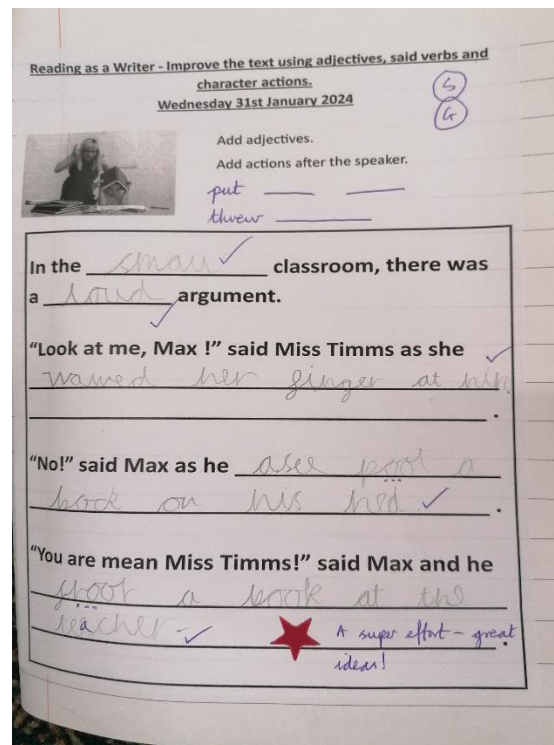
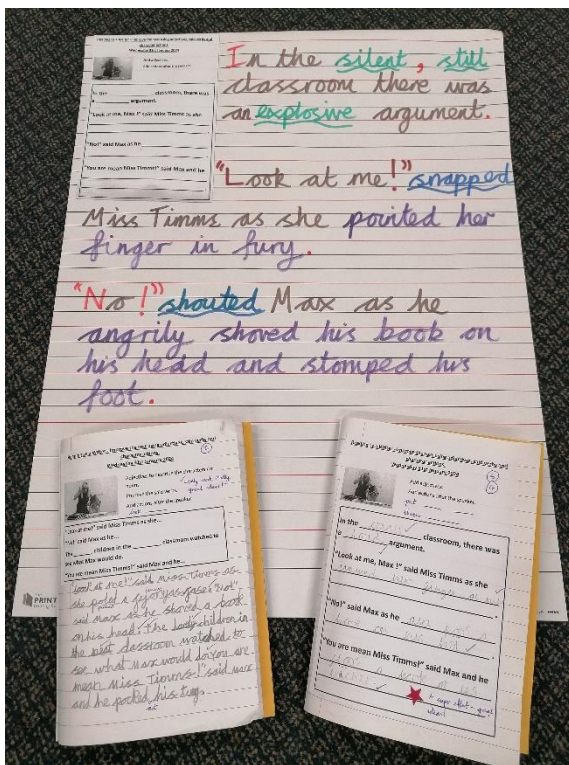


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# Class – Y2 Blue

We did some modelled writing beforehand, where we reminded ourselves of our character description toolkit and shared some ideas on whiteboards for each sentence.

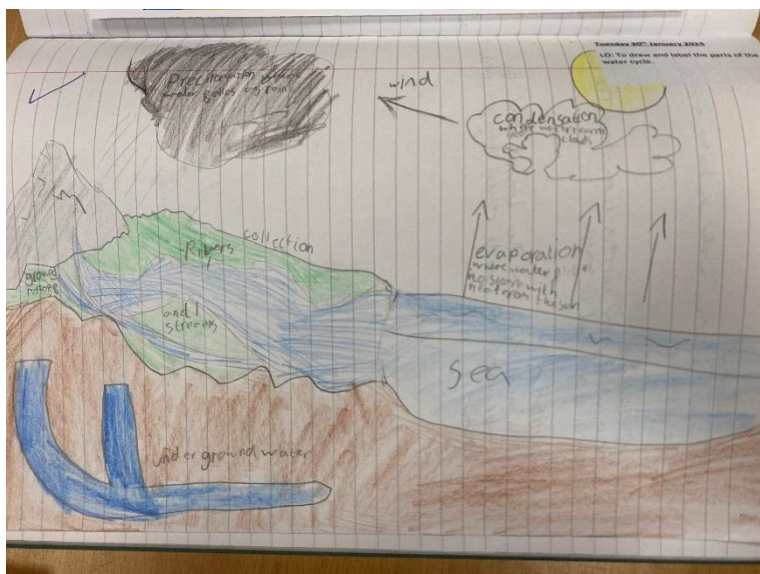
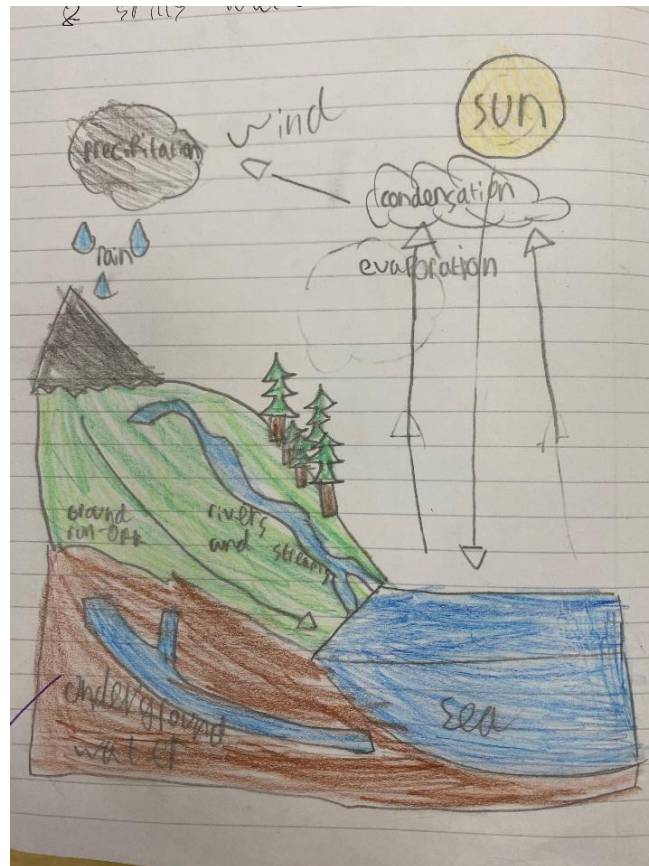
The children had so many great ideas and ambitious language, that I was spoiled for choice!
