Cheltenham Science Festival

- Tuesday 4th June 2024
- Imperial Gardens, Cheltenham
- Start time at venue 12:00pm (leave school approx. 11am)
- End time at venue 2:00pm
- Children will need a packed lunch
- School uniform must be worn with comfortable shoes to walk in
- Sun cream/hat/waterproof will be needed depending on the forecast – please check that morning

The activities during this trip will link to the children's work on Living Things and Habitats, Animals Including Humans and Properties and Changes of Materials:

- **Antarctic Adventures**
 - Embark on an exciting Antarctic adventure with scientists Helen Scales and Kate Hendry as you explore one of the most remote and challenging environments on Earth. Dive into an Antarctic expedition, learn how important life on Antarctica is to our planet, and discover how you can make a positive difference to the world.
- **Discover Zone**
 - Immerse yourself in a world of fun and interactive science in the Discover Zone. Journey through and get hands on with science, quiz scientists on their cutting– edge research and uncover how you can become a future changemaker. Who knows what you might discover...

Payment

The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £8.00 to cover the cost of the above activities.
