Science Festival

This activity links with our leading question, "How did British explorers shape our knowledge of the world?" to explore more about British explorers, travel in space and travelling across the world. During the morning, children will visit the Maker Shack, making things and being a crafter, creator and scientist to support our art work and STEM teaching. Children will also learn through a workshop called We Are All Astronauts with Kate Pankhurst, with rocket building and drawing.

Payment

The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £8.10 to cover the cost of all of the above activities. No child will be prevented from joining these activities because their parents do not pay but we must point out that an activity may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions.
