Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visits that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Term 6.

Cheltenham Science Festival

- Wednesday 5th June 2024
- Cheltenham Town Hall and Imperial Gardens
- Start time at venue 12:00pm (leave school by 11am)
- End time at venue 3:00pm
- Cherwell will return to school for 3:15pm
- Sherborne will return to school for 3:30pm
- Children will need a packed lunch
- School uniform must be worn with comfortable shoes to walk in
- Sun cream/hat/waterproof will be needed depending on the forecast please check that morning

The activities during this trip will link to the children's work on Earth and Space. Children will be inspired through a talk by Meganne Christian (a future astronaut) about what it takes to be an astronaut and the training involved. The talk will take place in Cheltenham Town Hall. Children will also spend time in the festival's Makershack to put their knowledge and skills into practice and learn more about all-things science.

Payment

The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £8.00 to cover the cost of the above activities. No child will be prevented from joining the activities because their parents do not pay but we must point out that an activity may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by Monday 20th May. If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

Permission and help

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's activity. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trips.
