Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visits that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Terms 3 and 4.

Wild Place Project

- Arrival back at school for 3:15pm
- School uniform should be worn with a coat
- Trainers can be worn as it may be a bit muddy
- Packed lunch, snack and drink is required – the kitchen can provide a packed lunch if needed

This activity links with our leading question, “How is rural Ghana different to Cheltenham?” to explore habitats, adaptation and food chains in Science along with comparing countries in Geography. During the day, the children will take part in an African Safari workshop and have access to the whole park.

Payment

The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £21.90 to cover the cost of all of the above activities. No child will be prevented from joining these activities because their parents do not pay but we must point out that an activity may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. **All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by Tuesday 25th March.** If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

Permission and help

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's activity. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trips.
