### Term 3 and 4 Educational Visits for Year 1

Dear Parents/Carers,

Now that arrangements have been finalised, we are delighted to tell you about the visits that we have arranged to enrich our curriculum in Terms 3 and 4.

#### Westonbirt Arboretum

- Wednesday 19th March 2025
- The National Arboretum, Westonbirt, Tetbury, GL8 8QS
- Leave school at 9:15am
- Arrival back at school for the usual pick up time of 3:15pm
- School uniform should be worn with a coat and trainers or wellies (weather dependent)
- Packed lunch, snack and drink is required – the kitchen can provide a school packed lunch if required

This trip links to our science topic. We will be identifying and naming a variety of common trees, plants and (possibly) animals. We will be learning about and naming the basic structures of flowering plants and trees. This trip will help to consolidate the children's science learning in school. During the visit, the children will have a Learn with Nature session based around the story The Tin Forest. Activities will also include a leaf hunt, meet a tree, plant lifecycles, a plant survival game and disappearing habitats.

#### Payment

**The school invites you to make a voluntary contribution of £11.50** to cover the cost of all of the above activities. No child will be prevented from joining these activities because their parents do not pay but we must point out that an activity may have to be cancelled if we do not receive sufficient contributions. **All contributions should be made via the ParentPay website by 28<sup>th</sup> February.** If you are experiencing difficulty, please contact the school office.

#### Permission and help

Permission is assumed when you make your contribution for your child's activity. You only need to email us if you're either unable to make a voluntary contribution but give permission for your child to attend, if your child receives Pupil Premium funding (see below) or if you are able to help on the trips. #### Pupil Premium
