Writing: The Tsunami Miracle

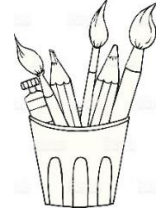
Write a story in first person to describe exactly what happened to an 11 year old boy when a terrible tsunami struck.

Geography: The Weather

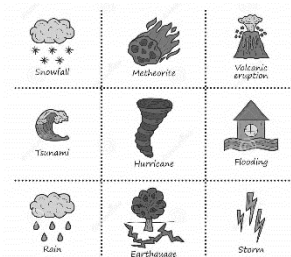
Make an instrument for measuring the weather. For example, measuring wind speed or direction or rainfall. Can you use your instrument and record your findings?

Art: Volcano Picture

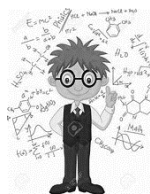
Create your own erupting volcano picture using whatever medium you would like to.
